The UConn School of Public Policy (SPP) connects state agencies, municipalities, and nonprofit organizations with second year graduate students from Master of Public Administration (MPA) and Master of Public Policy (MPP) programs.

- Employers select qualified MPA and MPP student interns through competitive application rounds between March-June.
- Partners have a dedicated UConn staff member to assist with their needs.
- MPA and MPP classes are held in the evening, allowing for flexible scheduling.

LOW COST, HIGH YIELD

The cost for an IPP intern to work in your organization is **\$17,250**. UConn SPP staff handles all administrative and payroll details.



585 HOURS

Graduate Interns work on special projects and provide program support for 15 hours a week for the academic year (August - May) – a total of 585 hours across 39 weeks.
