Top student candidate preferences submitted by April 12.

"EARLY MATCH", OFFERS, & CONFIRMATION

April 15: "Early Match" offers sent. April 17-26: Open offer period (similar to open job market)

- Prospective hosts create and submit job descriptions by February 29, 2024.
